After you release compression, the immediate picture you will see is a white spot that matches the compressed area. This is local ischemia as a result of skin compression. Soon you will see that this white spot changes color to pink or red. This is reflex hyperemia or direct evidence of vasodilation as a result of ischemic compression.

A venous leg ulcer is a wound that usually occurs on the medial aspect of the lower leg between the ankle and the knee as a result of venous insufficiency and ambulatory venous hypertension, with little or no progress towards healing within four to six weeks of occurrence. 4 The gold standard treatment is compression therapy with the aim of supporting venous return. 3,5 It has been noted that approximately 1% of the UK adult population will suffer from a venous leg ulcer at some point in ...

Graduated compression stockings are frequently used in the prevention of deep venous thrombosis and the treatment of venous insufficiency. Two patients are discussed who sustained ischaemic complications after application of graduated compression stockings. Review of the literature demonstrates that low cutaneous pressures significantly decrease local blood flow and that the amount of pressure exerted by graduated compression stockings increases significantly with increases in leg girth.
