PivotTables and PivotCharts in different workbooks are separate, each with its own copy of the data in memory and in the workbooks. Changes affect both PivotTables When you refresh the data in the new PivotTable, Excel also updates the data in the source PivotTable, and vice versa. When you group or ungroup items, or create calculated fields or calculated items in one, both are affected.

Click the PivotTable button in the Tables group on the Insert tab. Click the top portion of the button; if you click the arrow, click PivotTable in the drop-down menu. Excel opens the Create PivotTable dialog box and selects all the table data, as indicated by a marquee around the cell range.
