Has unexplained burns, bites, bruises, broken bones, or black eyes  
Has fading bruises or other marks noticeable after an absence from school  
Seems frightened of the parents and protests or cries when it is time to go home  
Shrinks at the approach of adults

Physical Signs An unexplained genital injury may suggest sexual abuse of a child. Sexual abuse may cause anal or genital bruising, tearing, stretching, or bleeding. Another physical sign is a sexually transmitted disease (STD) or

For example, a parent or caregiver withholds food from their child as a punishment for misbehaving. Physical abuse includes any behavior that involves the use of force to harm a child, such as punching, beating, kicking, biting, shaking, throwing, stabbing, choking, hitting or burning.
